A Brief History of MCA Day Chicago

Soon after Adam "MCA" Yauch died of neck cancer on May 4, 2012, Chicago-based performers Amy Sumpter, Kendra Stevens and Maggie Tomasek formed She's Crafty to help keep the spirit of MCA alive and pay homage to one of the most influential bands of the past 40 years. Since 2013, She's Crafty has been producing MCA Day Chicago events with bands, DJs and artists from across the Chicago area while raising money to fight cancer.

Fighting Cancer & Giving Back

She's Crafty partnered with the Brandon C. Gromada Head & Neck Cancer Foundation, named for a lifelong Beastie Boys fan who lost his iife to the same cancer as Adam Yauch one month after Yauch died. Over the past six years, She's Crafty has given proceeds from MCA Day Chicago to this incredible charity, raising more than \$10,000.

She's Crafty also honors Yauch's memory by donating their time, talents and money to charitable organizations like Planned Parenthood, RefugeeOne, Chicago Period Project, Gilda's Club and Women Employed.
